
Homework Project

Find about some famous heart surgeons. What do you need to study to become a heart surgeon? How long would it take if you started right now? What skills and personality would make you successful in this role?	3
Find out about the size and structure of a human heart. How are animals different? Compare lots of different animal hearts—size, structure and how many. Did you know worms have five?!	3
Create and construct a 3D model of either an actual animal or human heart. Use any form of materials that you can get your hands on. Don't forget to include same size, structure and colour.	4
Sketch the circulatory system using all the elements and directional arrows to show oxygenated and deoxygenated blood flowing around the body.	4
