



Remote learning timetable

As stated in our home learning policy, pupils are expected to compete at least 3 hours learning a day in Reception and KS1 and 4 hours in KS2. We provide 4 – 5 hours each day which equates to the learning time that pupils would receive in school. The timetable below sets out the learning that your child will need to complete each day and how we will provide feedback. Your Child's Class Teacher will contact you on a weekly basis to discuss any concerns that you might have. 		be worksheets linked to each lesson for your child to complete. These will be			
		uploaded to Google Classroom for pupils to complete on screen.
